Online IFTA Filing Instructions

[New Jersey](#) allows you to submit your quarterly IFTA tax return online. To file electronically using your Truckopedia-prepared IFTA report:

1. Log in to [New Jersey](#) IFTA online filing system
2. Enter your IFTA account details
3. Select the appropriate filing quarter and year
4. Follow the system prompts to enter the required information, including:
 - Total miles driven in each jurisdiction
 - Taxable gallons for each fuel type
 - Tax paid gallons purchased in each jurisdiction
 - Additional details required by your base state
5. Use your Truckopedia IFTA report to enter mileage, fuel, and tax details.
6. Review your information carefully before submitting your return.
7. Submit your return and arrange payment for any balance due, if applicable.

For the quarter ending [March 31, 2026](#), your return must be submitted online by [April 30, 2026](#) to be considered timely. To avoid late filing penalties and interest, please ensure you complete your online filing and submit any payment due by [April 30, 2026](#) deadline. Filing your return promptly ensures compliance with IFTA regulations and helps maintain your account in good standing. Interest and penalties may apply for returns filed after the due date.

Offline IFTA Filing Instructions

If you are filing by mail, please follow the steps below carefully before submitting your IFTA Quarterly Fuel Tax Report:

1. Review your IFTA Quarterly Fuel Tax Report completely to ensure all business details and IFTA account information are accurate. The report includes:

- a) State IFTA Quarterly Report
- b) Supporting IFTA report schedules

IMPORTANT NOTE: This workbook is only intended to help you prepare your IFTA quarterly tax return filing with your base jurisdiction and is not intended for direct submission. Please file your return through your base jurisdiction's official online portal or mailing process.

2. Print 2 copies of the IFTA Quarterly Fuel Use Tax Report and schedules

- a) Mail one copy to your base jurisdiction
- b) Supporting IFTA report schedules

3. Sign and date the report in the "Authorized Signatory" section

4. Include a check or money order payable to [NJ Motor Vehicle Commission](#)

- a) Payments to U.S. jurisdictions must be drawn from a U.S. bank in U.S. dollars

5. Make sure to include the following details on your check or money order:

- a) Your IFTA ID Number = [NJ-8675472](#)
- b) Due Amount = \$ [127.26](#)
- c) IFTA Tax Quarter = [Q1](#)

6. Arrange the package with the IFTA Tax Report placed above any supporting schedules

For the quarter ending [March 31, 2026](#), your return must be postmarked by [April 30, 2026](#) to be considered timely. To avoid late filing penalties and interest, we recommend mailing your completed IFTA return and any payment due at least 5–7 business days before [April 30, 2026](#) deadline. This helps ensure your return is postmarked and received by [April 30, 2026](#) in your base jurisdiction.

Consider sending your return by certified mail or using delivery confirmation so you have proof of the mailing date readily available. Retaining proof of timely filing, along with copies of your supporting records, may be important if your return is delayed, lost in transit, or reviewed by taxing authorities. Filing your return well before the deadline helps maintain your IFTA account in good standing. Late filing may result in penalties, interest, or, in certain cases, suspension of your IFTA license in certain cases.

Post Filing Notes

[New Jersey](#) will process the report and payment after submission. Refund policies vary by state, but most issue refunds within 4-6 weeks if the amount meets your jurisdiction's minimum refund threshold.

Record Keeping Requirements:

IFTA licensees are required to maintain records supporting the information reported on quarterly tax reports. These records must be kept for four years from the report date or filing date, whichever is later, and must be made available upon request by any member jurisdiction.

Required Distance Records

1. Individual Vehicle Distance Record must include:

- a) Trip start and end dates
- b) Trip origin and destination, including city and state
- c) Routes of travel
- d) Beginning and ending odometer readings
- e) Total trip miles
- f) Mileage by jurisdiction
- g) Vehicle unit number
- h) Driver's name

Required Fuel Records

You must maintain complete records of all fuel purchases for each fuel type, including diesel, gasoline, gasohol, propane, and natural gas. Fuel purchased for storage and over-the-road (O.T.R.) use should be recorded separately. The fuel records must contain:

- a) Date of purchase
- b) Seller name and address
- c) Number of gallons purchased
- d) Fuel type
- e) Price per gallon
- f) Vehicle unit number or license plate number
- g) Purchaser's signature

Acceptable fuel receipts include invoices, credit card receipts, or verifiable microfilm/microfiche copies. Altered or erased receipts may not be accepted by your base jurisdiction.
